



CLIMBING ROSES

Long, flexible canes support an exceptionally hardy, colorful and vigorous plant. Most often used for screening. A dramatic show of color mass for spots of color. Nonhardy varieties must be removed from trellis and protected.

NAME	COLOR	HEIGHT	COMMENTS
Brite Eyes	Salmon Pink	7 - 10'	Good climber for small gardens, disease resistant.
Henry Kelsey	Red	6 - 7'	Flowers freely, resistant to mildew, hardy on trellis in winter.
William Baffin	Deep pink	7 - 9'	Winter hardy on trellis, free-blooming, resistant to mildew.
Winners Circle	Red	6 - 8'	Dark glossy foliage, large blooms, non-fading.

LANDSCAPE ROSES

A family of modern hybrid shrubs to fit today's needs for low maintenance, seasons of landscape color and solutions for problem planting areas. Most landscape roses are prolific bloomers, compact in size & have good to excellent resistance to pest problems. May require some winter protection. R=Recurrent bloom, E=Everblooming

Carefree Celebration	R	Orange-Red	4'	Vigorous grower, glossy green foliage, superior disease resistance.
Carefree Delight	E	Pale pink	3'	Blooms spring to fall, glossy green foliage, easy-care.
Carefree Marvel	R	Deep pink	2'	Spicy fragrance, very winter hardy.
Carefree Spirit	E	Cherry Red w/wh eye	4 - 5'	Vigorous grower, excellent disease resistance
Carefree Sunshine	E	Clear yellow	3 1/2 - 4'	Blooms in abundant clusters from spring to fall.
Carefree Wonder	E	Hot pink	2 - 5'	Lightly fragrant flowers on a compact plant. Disease resistant.
Drift Roses	E	Red, pink, or coral	2'	Groundcover habit, attractive foliage, good disease resistance, continuous bloom. Requires a good mulch layer for winter.
Flower Carpet	E	Amber, coral, red, pink, scarlet & white	2 - 2 1/2'	Disease resistant. Comes in 3 separate colors. 4-6' wide.
The Fairy	E	Light pink	2'	Very hardy, disease resistant, 3' wide.
Knockout	E	Bright red	3 - 4'	Extraordinary hardy and reliable. It doesn't require any any special care to grow. Disease resistant.
Double Knockout	E	Bright red	3 - 4'	
Pink Knockout	E	Bright pink	3 - 4'	
Double Pink Knockout	E	Bright pink	3 - 4'	
Rainbow Knockout	E	Coral pink	3 - 4'

HARDY SHRUB ROSES

Exceptionally tough, withstanding hard freezes, wind, drought, even salt sprays. Most have recurrent blooms through the season and are the most trouble-free landscape roses available. No winter protection is required.

R =Recurrent bloom, E=Everblooming

Champlain	E	Red	3'	Profuse bloomer; orange rose hips in fall.
David Thompson	R	Fuchsia Pink	3 - 4'	Intense fragrance disease resistant foliage, hardy.
Lady Elsie May	E	Coral Pink	4'	Resistant to blackspot, Vigorous grower.
Little Mischief	E	Deep pink	1 - 2'	A low-growing ground cover rose with tiny, dainty flowers.
Morden Blush	R	Light pink to ivory	2 - 3'	Sweetly fragrant flowers; orange-red fruit in fall.
Morden Centennial	R	Medium pink	3 - 4'	Single and cluster booms, disease resistant.
Mystic Fairy	E	Rich Red	3'	Extremely resistant to black spot and mildew.
Nearly Wild	E	Pink	2 1/2'	Floribunda type, single-form, fragrant blooms. 3-4' wide.
Pink Meidiland	E	Bright pink	3 - 4'	A trouble free hedge or border of bright pink.
Seafoam	R	White to cream	3'	Double blooms in clusters, spreads 6-10' wide.
Sunrise Sunset	E	Pink blend	2 - 3'	which is very disease resistant.
Super Hero	E	Red	3 - 5'	Dark, satiny foliage, highly disease resistant, hardy.
Note: After planting, water with Fertilome Root Stimulator. Each year thereafter, fertilize with Fertilome Rose Food.
